



STARRING Judy Fisher

If you haven't had the pleasure of meeting Judy Fisher, you're in for a treat. Beloved by many and admired across our community, Judy's warmth and presence have made her something of a local treasure. In fact, some might even say a hometown celebrity.

As a longtime Friend of the Drexel, Judy asked "Where else can you see movies in your own neighborhood that have won Oscars, golden Globes, BAFTAs, Palm d'Ors, to name but a few? You can also buy a ticket to the latest Marvel franchise movie if that's where your tastes take you. The Drexel Theater is iconic. People come from all over not only to enjoy a movie, but also to revel in its 1930s Art Deco splendor."

This love of film and the Drexel, and some significant encouragement from Bill Conner, created a fantastic pairing. Bill Conner, the late CEO of CAPA, knew that Judy had the talent to lead the non-profit board that manages the Drexel Theatre in cooperation with CAPA. She saw the potential for expanded programming outside the first-run and repertory content that the Drexel was already famous for in the community. Her work in bringing the documentary "I Am Evidence" to the Drexel meant that people saw the theatre as a place to learn and grow, as well as to be entertained.

Because of her demonstrated skill at guidance and governance, Judy has been heavily engaged in a political life with The League of Women Voters, appointed by the Governor to the Ohio Children's Trust Fund, served on the boards of Jewish Family Services, Women's Political Caucus, and The Center for New Directions, a delegate to National Democratic Convention, and the ACLU, working on the elimination of racism, empowerment of women, good health care for all, fair housing and voters' rights. Her most meaningful endeavor was serving on the Development Committee for the creation of the YWCA Family Center for Homeless Women and Children and receiving the YWCA's Woman of Achievement Award – a proud moment in her community life.

You can see Judy on any morning walking through the streets of Bexley, routes she has walked for decades, wearing out many pairs of shoes in the process. After returning home after her walk she often remarks how splendid Bexley is; how lovely the experience of walking its streets is. She also loves to travel, to visit art museums, and attend ballet and music performances.

Judy has lived in Bexley with Ted for 52 years, in the same house, which they bought from the widow of the man who built it. Ted and Judy have two children, Abra and Evan, and 6 amazing and unique grandchildren.



ABOUT THE DREXEL



The Drexel debuted on Christmas
Day 1937 and for generations, the
Drexel Theatre has been central
Ohio's first source for independent
film and the best of Hollywood and
international cinema. Named among
the "Ten Best Art Blessings" by
The Columbus Dispatch, the
Drexel is Columbus' premier arts

cinema, providing unique programming in an eclectic, neighborhood film-going experience. The Drexel Theatre has officially been added to the National Register of Historic Places as a historic place worthy of preservation. Selected as a historic building contributing to the community's recreation and culture, the Drexel is only the fifth site in Bexley to be honored with this national designation.

A donation to the Drexel Celebration in honor of Judy Fisher is an essential part of supporting and sustaining the Drexel for generations. All Celebration donors will be recognized on the Drexel website and in theatre in 2026.
